

DALLAS TOWNSHIP - APPLICATION FOR PAVECUT AND STREET EXCAVATIONS PERMIT

PAVECUT AND STREET EXCAVATIONS MUST BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE #2004-2 AND THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN RELATION THERETO. A PERMIT MUST BE SECURED BEFORE ANY PAVECUT, OPENING, OR EXCAVATION OF ANY KIND IN ANY OF THE STREETS IN DALLAS TOWNSHIP IS MADE.

THE MINIMUM APPLICANT FEE IS \$100.00. ANY PAVECUT, OPENING, OR EXCAVATION IN EXCESS OF 10' SHALL PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$50.00 FEE FOR EACH 100' OR FRACTION THEREOF.

APPLICANT'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. PROVIDE TOWNSHIP WITH DETAILED DRAWINGS AND LOCATION MAPS AS REQUIRED BY PAVECUT AND STREET EXCAVATION ORDINANCE #2004-2.
2. CONTACT ALL UTILITIES THAT HAVE RECORDED THEIR FACILITIES IN COMPLIANCE WITH ACT (UTILITY LISTINGS MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE COUNTY RECORDER OF DEEDS).
3. ALL CONTRACTORS PERFORMING THE WORK MUST PROVIDE THE TOWNSHIP WITH PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE, SHOWING DALLAS TOWNSHIP AS AN ADDITIONAL PARTY INSURED.
4. PROVIDE TOWNSHIP WITH FINANCIAL SECURITY IN EITHER THE FORM OR CASH OR AN IRREVOCABLE LETTER OF CREDIT, AS SURETY IN THE SUM DETERMINED BY THE SCHEDULE OF FEES, AS PREPARED ANNUALLY BY THE TOWNSHIP ENGINEER, AND ALSO FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGES, CLAIMS, DEMANDS, SUITS, COSTS, AND COUNSEL FEES OCCASIONED OR ARISING FROM THE DIGGING UP, OPENING, OR CLOSING OF SAID STREETS. A BOND MAY BE SUBSTITUTED AS FINANCIAL SECURITY IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES IF APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.
5. NOTIFY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS WHEN THE OPENING OR EXCAVATION IS READY FOR BACKFILLING BEFORE ANY BACKFILLING IS DONE, WHEN BACKFILLING WORK IS COMPLETED, WHEN THE TEMPORARY PAVING HAS BEEN INSTALLED, AND WHEN THE STREET HAS BEEN PERMANENTLY RESTORED SO THAT INSPECTIONS MAY BE MADE.

BONDING AND INSURANCE MUST BE APPROVED BY THE TOWNSHIP SOLICITOR AND TOWNSHIP ENGINEER PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF ANY PERMIT.
