## Dallas Township Police Department to host National Night Out Event

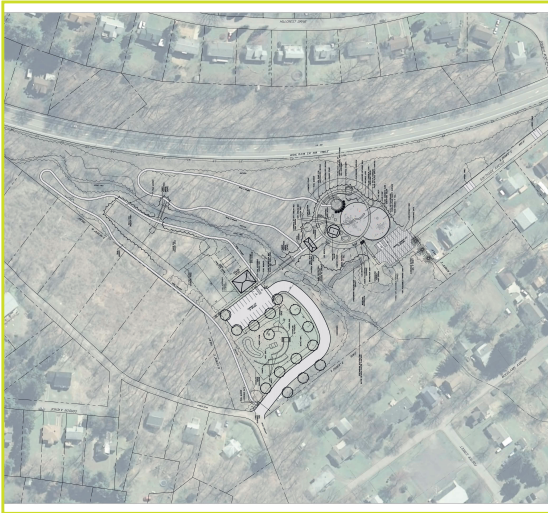

### Road Department News



Street sweeping was completed on May 31st. 34 miles of township paved streets were swept. Sweeping will continue throughout the summer as needed.

Spring clean up was May 6th-11th. The road crew assisted township residents with off loading there vehicles and fourteen 40 yard dumpsters were filled during the week and sent to landfill.

Summer Gravel road maintenance and repairs started on June 3rd. Weather permitting the crew will do work on all 9 miles of gravel from June till August. Goldsmith Road, Fern, Ridge and Summit Streets, Goodman Road, and Jake Moore Road are scheduled for June and July.
