Storm Water inlet and drain cleaning and repairs. Sectional paving repairs in progress. Summer Gravel road Maintenance in Progress. Dallas Township has 9 miles of gravel road and 7 miles have been completed since June 3rd. During the week of August 12, the crew will be working on Goodrich Road, Stredney Road and assisting Dallas Boro with their section of Reservoir road weather permitting.

Storm Water Pipe replacement on Glendalough Road, Pheasant Run Drive, and Church Road will start after August 14th! The Road crew will start scheduled paving projects after Summer Gravel Road maintenance is completed.
