Officer Balutis along with Dallas Township Police Chief Doug Higgins, were the first to arrive on scene and noticed the vehicle was on fire. Officer Balutis worked fast until first responders arrived to help extinguish the flames and pull the passenger away from the vehicle. Due to Officer Balutis' skill and quick thinking, the life of a young man was saved. The driver was life-flighted to a local hospital and thankfully today is doing well

with the hopes of one day becoming a police officer. Officer Brad Balutis received a Life Saving Award from the Policeman's Hall of Fame. The local fire departments that were on scene that day (Back Mountain Regional, Kunkle and Trucksville) also received a Life Saving Award for actions that saved the life of a local resident.
