The 2020 Dallas Township rescheduled spring clean up was a big success! The road crew was busy and 15, 40 yard dumpsters were filled and sent to landfill. The road crew thanks all residents that followed COVID-19 safety protocols. It was a hot week and our team pushed through!

The road crew will be clearing road side vegetation and starting scheduled summer road projects in July.

### 2020 contracted Milling and Paving

Eddinger Road contract: Milling, paving and line painting improvements have been completed. New Enterprise Stone and Lime Co. completed the work ahead of schedule and in budget. Supervisors opened bids for milling and paving of Harris and Lincoln Streets in the July 7th meeting. American Asphalt was the lowest bidder for this project. Milling and paving will start on Harris Street from Saddle Ridge Drive and go to the Lincoln Street intersection. Lincoln Street will be milled and paved from Harris Street and go into Lincoln Street for 800ft. Work will be starting late summer 2020.
