Dallas Township Police Department Implementing Body Cameras

Body-cameras have proven to be invaluable to the American law enforcement community. They boost data and record collection and strengthen community-law enforcement relationships. In fact, a prominent study on body-cams conducted by the Rialto, California Police Department found a 90% decrease in citizen complaints against officers who wore cameras. Our very own Dallas Township Police

Department is the first in the Back Mountain to implement body cameras. Body cameras are important because they capture crimes in progress, document police response, document victim, witness and suspect statements, record accident scenes, reduce unreasonable false complaints against officers, and they serve as a training mechanism for officers. The server for the cameras was purchased through an LSA Grant awarded to the police department and Dallas Township Supervisors authorized

\$20,765 for the individual cameras. Currently, Dallas Township is working on a policy and some facility changes to comply with Federal and State security guidelines. We are beyond proud of our Dallas Township Police Department for strengthening our community relationship with officers to ensure everyone's safety.
