Road Department Improvements

The Dallas Township Road department has been keeping busy this fall! The road department has been completing their curbside leaf pick up. The primary objective for the leaf vac is to clean out

the storm water channels. Township residents are reminded not to rake, push, or blow leaves into the roadway or near storm water channels or inlets. The drains can get clogged and backed up from the leaves. Make sure to put the leaves curbside. The leaf vac will make its way to all township streets throughout the season, weather permitting.



The Road Department has also made numerous township improvements throughout the summer and early fall. Some include: Paving on Southside Ave for the new nature based park, completed paving improvements of Glendalough Road, Richard Drive, and Yalick Road.

The addition of the new salt shed will help the road department with winter road maintenance practices. Cargill salt is the Costars provider for the 2021-2022 winter season and delivery has started. 300 tons of salt is expected for delivery by Thanksgiving.
