New Police Building Design

Earlier this year the Dallas Township Supervisors announced the purchase of the approx. 2.2-acre parcel located next to the Dallas Township municipal building on Lt. Michael Cleary Drive.

Thanks to a Local Shares Account (LSA) grant in the amount of \$367,000, the land was purchased from North Carolina-based

KQC Investors, LLC and Capital Investors III, LLC for \$205,000. The grant will also defray the costs associated with future site development work needed in preparation to build a new police station and to inevitably move operations to the new site.

The Supervisors have continued to look for additional grant funding to pay for the design and construction of an approx. 10,000 sq. foot structure that will house both the Dallas Township Police Department and Dallas Township Emergency Management Agency (EMA).

As preliminary planning has progressed and as additional grant

rounds continue to look promising, meetings with architectural firm Williams Kinsman Lewis Architecture have yielded conceptual designs based on the needs expressed by Township Police Chief Doug Higgins and his officers. Additional updates will be provided in future newsletters, and will also be announced at future Board of Supervisors meetings, which are held at 6:30 p.m. on the first Tuesday of each month.
