A Special Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Dallas Township was held on Wednesday, March 22, 2023 in the Administration Building located at 105 Lieutenant Michael Cleary Drive, Dallas, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania for the purpose of the Amended and Restated Dallas Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance (SALDO), the opening of the contracted milling & paving bids for The Maples and any other Township Business that may arise. The meeting began at 6:39pm which was immediately following the 6:30pm Public Hearing on the SALDO.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor Wagner made a Motion to Amend the agenda to include Resolution 2023-8, A Resolution for Plan Revision for New Land Development for the Kirk Subdivision, seconded by Supervisor Martin and carried.

Supervisor Grant stated that we just had a public hearing on the Amended and Restated SALDO. Supervisor Martin asked some questions concerning the process and the costs involved with doing a minor subdivision/lot line adjustment as she may want to do one and also had some inquiries about this. Engineer T. Doughton explained the process and discussed some of the costs involved. You would need a registered surveyor or registered engineer for this process.
