North Main Street Emergency Streambank Stabilization

On January 9, 2024, the Dallas Township and Kingston Township Road Departments worked together to reinforce the Toby Creek wall along North Main Street on the township border. The temporary repairs were necessary to prepare for future rain events and the potential rapid melting of snow from previous snowfalls.

Under the supervision of John Levitsky from the Luzerne Conservation District, crews worked diligently to place large rocks and boulders along the creek wall while also clearing debris from the creek bed and shoreline.

Although this temporary solution is effective, a more permanent fix is currently in development. Stay tuned for further details as they becomes available.









Sago Street Road Closure

Starting January 22, 2024, Sago Street, located off SR 309 Highway, will undergo temporary closure as PennDOT is working to replace and/or repair the sanitary sewer inlet manhole covers. This initiative is a part of PennDOT's continuous efforts within the broader box culvert project. Detours are in place for local traffic.
