**FEES:**

**Cars:** Unlimited.

**Pick-up Trucks & Trailers:** The first trip is free. After the first load:

- Trucks and Trailers with 6ft. box will be charged \$15.00.
- Trucks and Trailers with 8ft. box will be charged \$20.00.

**Cargo Vans, Box Trucks, and Dump Trucks:** Will be charged accordingly.

**Tires:** 4 tires per household - \$5.00 per tire.

**The following items will not be accepted:** Electronic items such as TVs, computers, monitors, and printers - freon-based appliances such as refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, and water coolers - Hazardous materials or chemicals - yard waste, leaves, grass, animal/human waste, or newspapers - Concrete, sheetrock, or any other building materials.

Proof of residency will be required at the time of drop-off. Fees will apply for bulk items such as carpets, overstuffed chairs, couches, dressers, and mattresses.

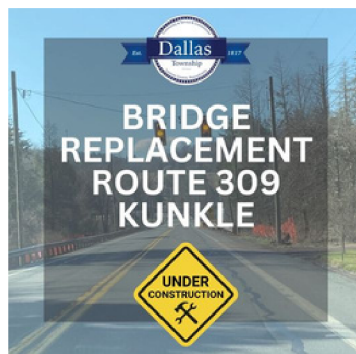
